# The conflict at a glance

---

- **Parties involved:** United States, Israel, Iran (with regional spillover risks)
- **Nature of situation:** Direct military confrontation with regional implications
- **Geographic focus:** Iran, Israel, Gulf region, key US bases in the Middle East
- **Current status:** Fluid and rapidly evolving
- **Risk level:** High risk of wider regional escalation (analyst consensus)



# Why Cameroon should watch

- Cameroon is sensitive to global oil price shocks
- Many Cameroonians live and work in Gulf countries
- Shipping and aviation routes affecting Africa may be disrupted
- Inflationary pressure could affect transport and prices of goods and services
- Potential diplomatic positioning at African Union and UN

- Government reaction or silence from Yaoundé
- African Union position
- Impact on air travel routes affecting Africa
- Market reactions (transport, food prices)
- How Middle East tensions historically affect Cameroon
- Cameroon's oil import vulnerability
- Cameroonians working in Gulf countries

## Official sources

- Statements from US, Israeli and Iranian authorities
- African Union communiqués
- Cameroon Ministry of External Relations
- Civil aviation authorities



## Verified Sources Cont'd

---

### Technical/data sources

- Global oil market trackers
- Flight tracking platforms
- Maritime shipping monitors
- Local fuel prices



## What to do when reporting

---

- ✓ Check multiple trusted sources before reporting
- ✓ Localise the story
- ✓ Numbers, quotes, and maps should be clearly sourced.
- ✓ Avoid sensational language.
- ✓ Reverse search images, confirm video timestamps, and check metadata before sharing
- ✓ Include analysts or academics to explain impact, but distinguish opinion from facts.
- ✓ Update continuously



## What NOT to do

---

- ✗ Don't amplify unverified claims
- ✗ Don't assume relevance is obvious
- ✗ Avoid overly dramatic headlines or fear-inducing language; stick to facts
- ✗ Don't rely on a single source
- ✗ Don't overload your audience with raw data
- ✗ Don't compromise safety or security
- ✗ Don't overlook attribution
